to acquire and/or install textbooks, technology equipment, and/or other educational usage material and/or equipment from the proceeds of bonds maturing within five (5) years from their date	\$ 75,000.00
to acquire and/or install playground equipment and perform playground site improvements	\$ 32,500.00
